The cost of living crisis is making life difficult for many working people and amongst those hardest hit are parents, carers and grandparents.

- Nearly half of all unpaid carers have had to cut back on essentials such as food, heating, clothing and transport costs.
- 85% of parents in Usdaw feel their finances have got worse over the last 12 months – and this continues to rise.
- Over three-quarters of parents say that the pressure of financial worries is having an impact on their mental health.

Parents and carers deserve better; their unpaid work is crucial to the economy and to those they care for.
