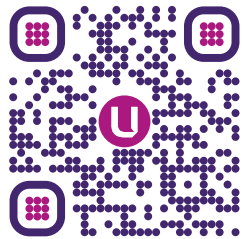

The whole site can also be translated into different languages!

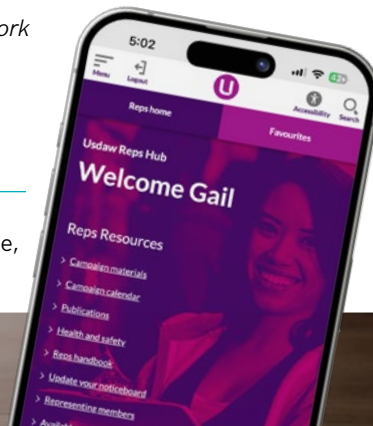
